

Support for people living alone or with an equally Vulnerable carer through:

- Home visits by staff and volunteer befrienders
- Emotional support and a listening ear
- Information, advice and signposting
- Consistency for the person
- Support for as long as needed
- "Joining up the dots" where several agencies are involved in different aspects of a person's wellbeing.
